Resolution No. 588-Revised

PROPERTY TAX INCREASE RESOLUTION – 2025

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 40 has properly given notice of the public hearing held on October 25, 2024, to consider the fire district's current expense budget and revenue needs for the 2025 calendar year, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 40, after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that King County Fire Protection District No. 40 requires an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and any amount authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the fire district and in its best interest.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 40 that an increase in the regular property tax levy, in addition to the increase resulting from addition of new construction and improvements to property, including refunds, and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and any amounts authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred, is hereby authorized for the 2025 levy in the amount of \$4,882,000 which is a dollar increase in the levy from the previous year of \$182,000 (a percentage increase of 3.87% from the previous year).
